### **Meeting commenced at 7:07pm**

1. Approval of Agenda
  - Agenda approved. Bruce first, Paul S second.
2. Approval of Previous Minutes
  - Previous minutes approved. Sherri first, Bruce second.
3. 3D Hosting Manual
  - Paul R distributed a provincial 3D hosting manual outlining standards and expectations for hosting.
  - Cadets are shooting from wrong stakes, this manual will allow for clarity for shooting correct distances.
  - Paul R to compose a draft email to clubs asking for feedback, Ryan to send out. Once deadline for feedback passes, AANS Board will vote to approve and implement hosting manual.
  - Once approved, Ryan will post on website.
  - Paul R motions to approve process. Bruce first, Sherri seconds.
4. 3D Funding Criteria
  - Paul R and Sherri modified previous 3D funding criteria's to create this year's criteria.
  - Ryan to post on website once approved.
  - Paul R motions to approve 2017 3D funding criteria. Paul S first, Bruce seconds.
5. Junior Membership
  - Paul R and Sherri propose a \$25.00 junior membership to encourage greater youth participation.

- Bruce notes that it isn't the price that is discouraging youth participating, but that there is a greater need for communication between clubs and NASP programs.
  - There is a greater need for youth recruitment and this is a way towards this.
  - Ryan suggests the cost should be \$30.00, and the age should be 18 and under rather than 21 and under.
  - Paul R motions AANS to create youth membership at a rate for \$30.00 for those 21 and under beginning in the new membership year (approximately September 2017). Bruce first, Sherri second.
- 6. Bruce Scott Write Up Approval**
- Jason suggests a picture be included with the write up
  - Paul S to send picture to Paul R on Monday, June 12<sup>th</sup>.
  - Paul R to make minor edits and then send to Archery Canada.
  - Duncan Crawford has already paid for Bruce Scott to be in the Book of Remembrance, but AC suggests NS includes a donation.
  - It is suggested another person be included with a write up and the appropriate donation. John Webber is suggested.
  - Paul R motions that the write up be approved to be sent to Archery Canada. Jason first, Sherri second.
  - Paul R motions that John Webber be included in the Book of Remembrance with donation. Jason first, Paul second.
- 7. Milk Sport Fair Report**
- The Sport Fair was a great success. Over 1,100 children tried archery.
  - Paul R encourages continued participation in the Milk Sport Fair.
  - Paul R notes strong volunteer turnout for booth.
  - Paul R suggests free membership for both Fred and Denise Newell for their help at the Milk Sport Fair. Sherri first, Paul S second.
- 8. Membership Coordinator**
- Ryan suggests that there is a call for membership coordinator.
  - Ryan to email clubs with notice and Board to vote on person.
  - Paul R motions for creation of membership coordinator position to work with Administrative Coordinator. Jason first, Paul S to second.
- 9. Nationals Update**
- Paul R has been in discussion with Chad Harpell
  - Victoria Park is approved but awaiting for official approval from the new Park Manager. In talks with Dalhousie Agriculture for dorms, banquet hall and other needs.
  - Ryan and Paul R to assist Chad with organization of Nationals.
- 10. New Business arising**
- Bruce inquiries about advertisement of shoots. Clubs need to send information to Ryan to be posted on website.
  - Discussion around requirements for a provincial judge and it is unclear.
