Funding Archers to travel to Canadian Outdoor (Field and) Target Championships

2015 Target Team Selection Criteria

2015 Canadian Outdoor Target Championships August 4 – 9, Winnipeg, Manitoba

The criteria are both objective for the basic selection, and flexible enough to consider external influences such as budget restrictions and considerations for the potential for individual medals. We also consider team contribution and contributions given to our sport when making the selection.

To be considered for funding, an athlete must be a member of AANS and must declare his/her intention to the Provincial Coach and Target Director, in writing, by June 1st 2015. Those athletes under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an un-funded parent or guardian. As members of the provincial archery team, archers are expected to comply with all policies of AANS.

A copy of completely filled out, signed and witnessed score cards for registered outdoor target events must be sent to the Provincial Coach and Target Director, postmarked on or before Aug 1, 2015. Score cards must be signed by the Certified Judge officiating at these events.

AANS Funding:

Each team member will receive equal amount of funds from AANS, with the exception of the archer qualifying for the Archery Canada subsidy. All archers are required to disclose any other funding.

If extra funding is available from other sources, beyond our regular grant, specifically for a particular category, it may transcend these rules of selection. Local transportation for the team will be provided by the team's rented vehicle if/and when available, augmented if possible by archer's and volunteers' vehicles.

Qualifying Scores:

Qualifying scores are not used to restrict team admission, but to assess the archer's performance when selecting special teams (such as for the Fred Usher Cup). The archer's qualifying score will be the average of their best three (3) registered FITA Stars, shot between August 1, 2014 and July 31, 2015. Two of these scores must be shot during the 2015 outdoor season.

Team selection for the Fred Usher Memorial Cup team round will be left at the discretion of the Team Coach at the event or, in his or her absence, any AANS Executive member present.

Archery Canada Funding:

Archery Canada may partially subsidize the travel of one archer attending the National Target and Field Championships.

If the Archery Canada budget allows, this archer will be selected as follows: The archer's qualifying score will be compared against the Archery Canada FITA Star Record of that archer's category (see chart below). The archer whose average represents the highest percentage of the record will be chosen. The following formula will be used to compare the average to the record:

$$(\text{Archer's Average Score} \div \text{National Record}) \times 100$$

If outside funding is received, the Archery Canada funding will be awarded to the archer with the next highest percentage of the national record.

Athletes wishing to participate in a category beyond their regulation age category must receive written permission from the Executive to be eligible for funding.

The following table shows the national record for each category. These scores were taken from the Archery Canada internet site as of October 3/2011. The Archery Canada website will be taken to be correct in case there are any errors in the table below.
