



Archery Nova Scotia is constantly working to increase participation in the sport of archery. To that endeavour, Archery Nova Scotia is implementing a new Try-It Event Funding program to assist all of its member clubs in reaching the maximum number of new potential archers. Below are the programs guidelines:

1. Archery Nova Scotia will provide funding to assist with Try-It Event(s) expenses for each club. Each club is eligible for a maximum of \$100 per fiscal year, September 1 to August 31.
2. Archery Nova Scotia will only provide funding for Club sponsored events. Individuals are not eligible to receive funding for Try-It events. All cheques for Try-It funding will only be written to a club.
3. Clubs must submit an AANS Expense Claim form with the details of the event at least 14 days prior to hosting the event(s), for approval by the Board of Directors.
4. Archery Nova Scotia will provide advertising for all event(s) on the Archery Nova Scotia website and Facebook page.
5. Clubs agree to record every event attendee in their Short-Term Participant log book that AANS will provide to each club at the AGM. AANS will collect their completed log books at the following year's AGM and store them for every club. If a club does not complete and submit their log book(s), that club will be ineligible for the Try-It Event Funding Program for the following year.
